1. - 2. It is desired that you provide your own transportation from your home to the Reception Center. Upon arrival at the Reception Center, the Government will reimburse you for the cost of travel at the rate of five cents (\$.05) per mile from your home to Fort Sheridan, Illinois. Privately owned automobiles cannot be taken to station of active duty.
- 3. Uniforms and equipment will be furnished you at the Reception Center. You should take only the minimum amount of civilian clothing to the Reception Center. Underwear, handkerchiefs, toilet articles, etc. may be taken, although you will be issued a toilet kit and these items after reporting.
