You are hereby notified that your application for leave clearance dated February 12, 1943 has been considered by the Director, and he has instructed me that

The application has not been considered by the Japanese-American Joint Board, however, and any application for indefinite leave you may file that involves residence or employment in the Eastern Defense Command must be submitted to the Director for approval.

\_\_\_\_\_ The Provost Marshal General's Office of the War Department has determined that you are eligible for employment in plants and facilities vital to the war program.

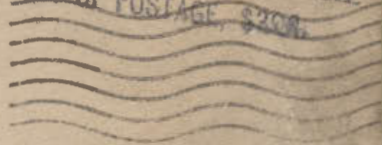
