Dear Mr. Nakamura:


The Illinois Veterans Compensation Act provides "Every person who served in active duty in the military or naval service...and who, at the time of entering such service, was a resident of the State of Illinois,...shall be entitled to receive...compensation...".

An examination of your application and the supporting documents submitted, indicate that you were not a resident of the State of Illinois at the time of your entry into military service, within the meaning of the Act and the interpretations of the Service Recognition Board with relation thereto.

Under the provisions of the Act, quoted above, the Service Recognition Board has no authority to allow your claim. I regretfully inform you that your claim has been denied.

You are hereby notified that you have a right, if you so desire, to request that this determination be reviewed by a Board of Review, which is to be established in the near future.
