Dear George,

I am sorry I didn't answer your letter sooner.

I received a letter from Emiko right after I received yours, and she said they are expecting you any day at camp so I thought I better not write to you until your furlough was over. I imagine you are back at the camp by now, because I had a greetings card from Emiko from Chicago. There is no need to ask if you had a wonderful time on your furlough, is there? Did you see the folks and Emiko? Emiko was so excited and waiting anxiously

about your visit - that I hope you went to see her and spend a few days with her.

Now that the war is over I am glad that everybody is happy. It won't be very long now before you can join your family, ne?

Did you find out whether the folks are coming back to California or not? I haven't heard about it yet from anybody so I am still waiting to know.

No, I haven't had any word from my mother & dad ever since the war started. I didn't worry much until lately though. Now the war is over I am happy

and anxious to know about them but still afraid to know whether they are alright or got killed.

Yes, Kiyomi-san is the mother of four children now. I received a letter from her husband telling me that a baby boy was born on July 13th. I guess she is pretty busy.

Hatsue-san's baby must be pretty big by now. I surely would like to see the baby.

I have some pictures from One-san not long ago and I was really surprised to see Hiroko's picture.

Gee, she sure got big!  
She looks like her dad, I think.



There is no news around here.  
You said it is tiresome to  
travel around the country  
but it is tiresome to stay  
in bed year after year, too.  
I guess we all want to be  
different than what we are  
now, ne?

Well, I guess I close for  
now. Take good care of  
yourself and write to me  
again.
