Dear George:

We took train on the 57th at about 9:00 a.m., and reach Fresno about 2:30 p.m.

The camp is a pretty good place. We get a bed and mattress and spring. We also got blankets. The room is quite big, and the food is alright.

That's enough on the camp, but how are you, Jim, and Jack? By now you're out of school, so you have to work but I don't have to. What did Mr. Hooley give you for the quarter.

We live next to the mess hall so we could hear the call right ~~in~~ away.

We got a regular store out here but we have to use coupons and they don't accept money.

Well I can't think about anything else so goodbye.
