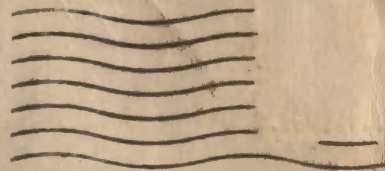
Guess you're busy and I'm out of words so excuse my sudden ending.
