nowadays? Guess the labor shortage has a effect on the work hasn't it. Any it certainly is harder out here now, than it was in California a couple years ago.

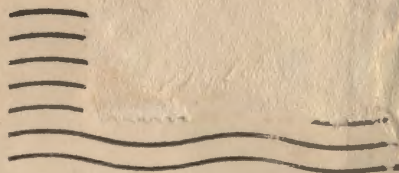
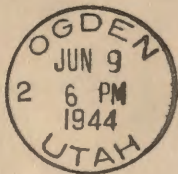
Are you still keeping all those turkeys? If you are I guess you're having your hands full!
