

Oct 27, 1942

Dear George,

We came into Jerome on the 21 first at night about six and had to wait till about 8 before we got settled. After that we went after our baggage and it was about 11:00 when we slept.

The next two days we had to haul our freight and yesterday make tables and chairs so now I got an excuse for not writing sooner.

The trip out to here was a long one. From 3:00 P.M. on the 16th to 6:00 C.M. on the 21st. Another word six days and 5 nights. The meals were ~~as~~ very good on the train. From Fresno we went to Stockton, then Sacramento, Nevada, Utah, Colorado, Wyoming, Nebraska, Missouri, Kansas, Tennessee, Arkansas.

I haven't much to tell except we have a bigger room here and I think it's going to be a good place.

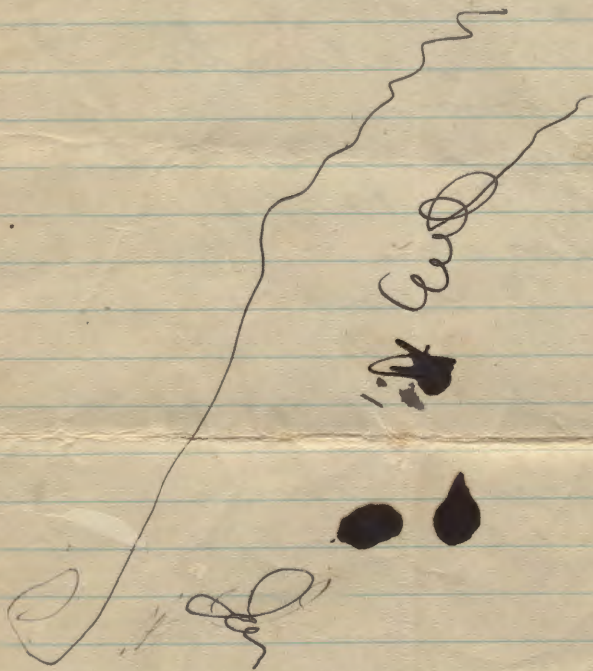
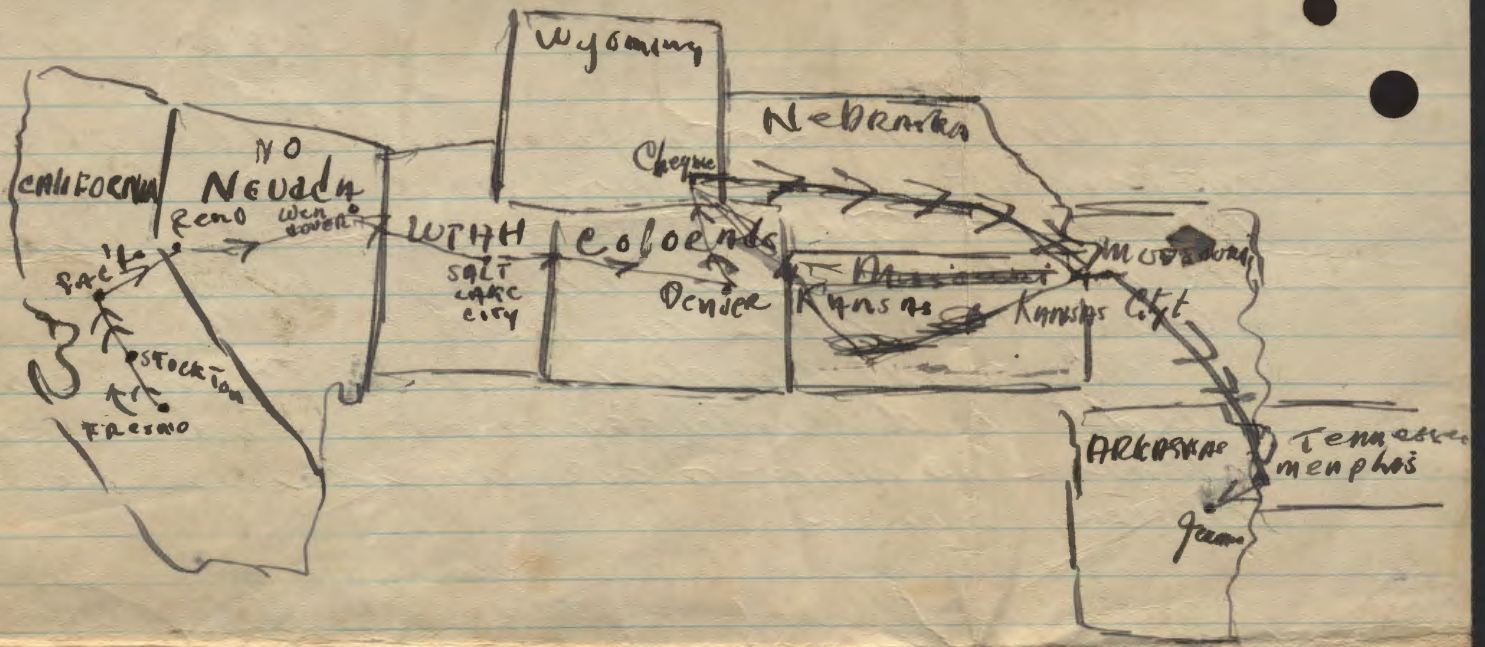
By the way, how are you doing? How's school. Got your first report card?
