I can't even hear the officers talking to me half of the time and it's

quite embarrassing to have to ask
the officers to repeat each statement
or question.

Well George, I'm really glad to
hear that those (super patient)
got there parts scared off, but
more than that I'm glad to
know that there are people like
you & your family which makes
the world worth fighting for.
Keep up the good work George and
just trust in God.

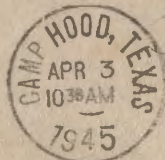
I haven't written to Jim as yet
