Thanks for the lemon pie it was delicious. Well, the day before we evacuated from Brighton we couldn't sleep at night because we were so excited about going on a train ride. We started out of Perkins station at 8:30 and reached here about 2:30. We passed alot of place on the way here. We went through Flowin, Elk Grove, Fodi, Stockton, Merced, Chowchilla, & Brenda and we stopped at the Fresno Station and then boarded a bus to Pinedale. Gee! but the train ride was fun! You know its

here we were received  
by the people from our  
town, who came before us.  
It was quite pretty we  
arrived. Today we got  
our inoculation shots  
for Typhoid and small  
pox. We are on the  
last house on the end  
of the field. It was quite  
a long walk from where  
the bus left us. We  
are all fine and in  
good health. I have nothing  
to do yesterday or today.  
They say we are only going  
to stay here at least  
2 weeks or more and  
choose any place we want  
to go from here. Until I  
hear from you.
