

Past and present shortcomings regarding food situation

1. General shortage of food supply (delivery is always short)
2. No system. (Receipt signed for those not delivered)
(Blank invoices even signed. Refusal threatened)
(No inspector.) Perishable food not to lay in warehouse)
3. Inequality of distribution; no efficiency.
(Requisition not sent from office to warehouse in time, often
as late as 6:00 PM)
4. Amount of food allowance not definitely known.

Proposals:

1. Adoption of unified menu; unified requisition system.
2. Adoption of punch card system for mess halls.
3. Build sufficient food reserve.
4. Appointment of efficient personnel to guarantee smooth
carrying into effect of new system.
5. Request project director to issue public statement to alleviate
uneasiness.
