A discussion took place on the following problems.

As a result we are requesting that the Administration please take into consideration:

1. Speedy distribution of coats (jackets). There are a number of men going from block to block without adequate protection from the cold weather. *W.R.A. give all out side work. chairmen too*

now 150 at 3 every day
2. Efficient arrangement for speedy distribution of vital necessities (mattresses, blankets, and coal). *OK. group adjust.*
"Above is particularly requested of Mr. Carrol on the day dated."

3. To furnish soldiers who visit the camp with necessary bedding.

4. Establishment of milk-station in each mess hall. "Mothers who are alone with the baby on hand feel it is too far to walk, as it is at present."

5. Placement of a dietitian at each mess hall for the sick. *(特別手回子と室と)*
