

October 19, 1942

At 17-25 North $\frac{1}{2}$ End 8:30 A.M.

Mr. Tsukai reported: Coal Foreman Izawa requested supply of dump truck.

Roll call was taken by the Chairman: Absentees were Messrs. Okazaki, Kaneko, and Hara.

1. a. Chairman read memorandum, requesting recommendation of a person from each block to assist Employment Division.
- b. Mr. Nagamori explained:
 1. 600 census cards available
 2. B.A.O. to make arrangement of choosing a census taker from his block to handle labor supply by lining up with the Employment Division.
 3. Census taker to be put on pay roll.
 4. Census to be taken of persons from 14 to 65 years of age, both men and women.
 5. Give a week's allowance to complete census.
2. a. Mr. Nagumo proposed to supply food between meals in the morning and in the afternoon to coal crew by their respective mess halls. Motion seconded by all present.
Mr. Chairman ordered Secretary to submit request with Mr. Haller, Chief Steward of the Mess Division.
3. a. Mr. Nagumo proposed to supply fire crew in each block with four whistles.
Motion seconded unanimously.
4. a. Mr. Fujimoto and Mr. Mineta jointly proposed relief measures on personal property in storage.
 1. To press for issuance of property redeeming form.
 2. To provide exceptional case for those who request their property to be kept intact.
5. a. Mr. Fujimoto moved motion to increase wages of canal workers to the maximum.
Majority objected to the motion.
6. a. Mr. Oka reported conditions in which invalid and insane as well as their neighbors are placed. Proposition was made by the same to provide a barrack specially provided for such abnormality. Proposition considered untimely due to necessity for immediate transfer of such persons to the hospital, and until such provision is completed. Committee moved motion to send Health Committee to recommend later motion.
7. a. Mr. Ishikawa proposed the basis of electing charter drafting committee as follows:
 1. One issei and one nisei to be elected from each block as block representatives.
 2. Seven issei and one nisei to be elected from each block as block representatives as Charter Drafting Committee and the rest of representatives to fill advisory capacity.Motion seconded by the committee.
8. a. Mr. Koide requested secretary to submit memorandum for Tuesday's discussion with Mr. Rachford in regard to recreation reserve fund and means for additional fund.
9. Meeting adjourned at 11:30 A.M.
