

Roll call was taken by Mr. Chairman. The absentees were Messrs. Fujioka, Yoshihashi, Hara and Kakuuchi.

Introduction of Mr. K. Kawahara of Block 7 to the Chairmen's Council. Introduction of Miss Rosie Nakagawa as assistant secretary.

1. Reports by Mr. Chairman on the meeting of Community Cooperative Enterprise Set-up Committee:
 - a. Attendants: approximately 14 members.
 - b. Disputations by individuals on election of block representatives as undemocratic;
 - (1) Sudden election of block representatives.
 - (2) Exclusion of study group in majority.
 - c. Misunderstanding by few individuals as to the nature of the Cooperative Enterprise Set-up Committee in such a way that the said Committee was considered as an organizing committee of the Cooperative Enterprise instead of a set-up committee. The misconception was cleared by Chairman Hayashida's explanation.
2. Discussion on approved renewed recommendation in the method of selecting a Charter Drafting Committee.
 - a. Date of meeting to select one citizen and one non-citizen from each block: Contact Committee to find a definite date of said meeting from Mr. Rachford.
 - b. To send proclamation to all relocation projects urging them to write to Washington D.C. through the Charter Drafting Committee;
 - (1) On the claim of equal basis of privileges and rights of non-citizen as that of a citizen in forming the Community Council, holding elective offices, and other positions.
 - (2) That the said proclamation is to be issued from the representative body of citizen and non-citizen groups.Motion moved by Mr. Koide and seconded unanimously.
 - c. To publicize on bulletin by Information Committee the course of events and renewed recommendation in the method of selecting a Charter Drafting Committee and to explain to the public at such gatherings as Adult's night schools in an effort to make the intention of the joint committee of B.A.O. and Block Chairmen's Council clear to them. Above motion by Mr. Koide was amended by Mr. Ishikawa to carry on after contacting the B.A.O. on the subject to be released to the Press.
3. Mr. Nagumo proposed the following problems:
 - a. To supply school children with proper school requisites.
 1. Mr. Koide amended:
 - (1) That faculty members of Japanese ancestry as a body taking action of above proposition;
 - (2) That the Temporary Chairmen's Council to support formerly the said proposition in line with the Japanese faculty members.Amendment seconded unanimously.
 - b. To unify the amount on presents to be exchanged with respect condolences and congratulations.

Motion amended:

 - (1) To restrict amount of presents within understanding of

(2) To agree on the least amount possible if necessary.

c. To abolish exchange of Christmas presents.

Mr. Gorai moved motion to request withdrawal of display on sales of luxuries such as furs.

Motion seconded unanimously to have Community Enterprise Committee to petition said proposal with Mr. Todd.
