1. Mr. Chairman read a letter from the Police Department on the subject of ash disposal: Put out ashes when disposing by pouring water on the embers.
2. Mr. Chairman requested opinion with regard to sugar beet labor as per request made by Mr. Paulley.
Mr. Mineta proposed to request financial guarantee of workers. The Labor Committee to report to Mr. Paulley.
3. Mr. Tsunokai proposed to request medical supplies to hospital. Motion seconded unanimously.
4. A. Mr. Carter, Superintendent of the Education Dept. made the following suggestions:
 - a. Name of organization to be Parent-Teacher's Coordinating Council of Heart Mountain instead of P.T.A.
The Council seconded the motion.
 - b. Type: One representative from each block to PTCC.
Mr. Koide amended: 3 committee members to be selected from each block to discuss on educational problems, one of which attends the P.T.C.C. Motion seconded.
 - c. Objectives:
 - 1) Promote the welfare of children and youth in home, school, church, and community.
 - 2) Relation between home and school, parents and teachers.
 - 3) Development of unity between the educators, and general public such united effects as will secure physical, mental, social, and spiritual education.
- b. Opinions on Resident Teachers:
 - a. Majority working all right. Minority still unexperienced; therefore, needs training.
 - b. Number of resident teachers:
 - 1) Day school program--23
 - 2) Night school program--30
- c. Salaries for resident Teachers: No control on army set-up for salaries of resident teachers to make it in equivalent with that of Caucasians.
- d. Full sympathy to supply school requisites by the State as long as we pay sales tax, but we are bound to the State Statutes which does not provide such item in it. The example is shown in a case of tourists who do not receive any protection even if they pay tax for gasoline.
5. Mr. Koide proposed to request distribution of clothing allowances to:
 - a. Those who are not qualified to claim clothing allowances on account of insufficient working days in September due to their late arrival here, but had more than 15 working days in the months of July, August, and Sept. in the assembly Centers prior to their relocation to this project.
 - b. Those who did not receive order for work but had filed application thereof.
 - c. Those who are not covered in above categories on the basis of public grants.
