Your acceptance of the proposition resulting from our conference on November 5, 1942 was presented to the ex-policemen at the meeting called by us 2:00 p.m. Friday, November 6, 1942.

After our explanation of the above, our Committee disbanded and the meeting was continued by the said volunteer group to discuss your submitted proposals.

We now feel that a true and correct picture of the present controversy was not properly understood and presented to you by us; and that the problem of the now suspended persons, Messrs. Matsui, Ozeki, and Santschi was not the primary issue.

The attached counter proposals of the said volunteer group we understand are the unanimous voice and result of their meeting.
