1. Mr. Rachford made following reports:

1. Work clothing allowances turned down by the W.R.A. Director in Salt Lake City but case remains open for specification.

2. Request consideration privately among the "Family" on the matter of:

b. Disappeared: lumber including 12-in. shelving for library by mistake unloaded at the shop instead of at the library

c. Disappointment in police problem which is becoming worse
