1. Disbursement of Wages:

Mr. Yokota suggested to pay wages at each block mess hall. Mr. Nelson said he would take the proposal under consideration.

2. Wages Problems:

1. Date of Wages Disbursement:

- a. Cash bond in process.
- b. Sept. and October pay rolls being typed already and sent to Denver first part of last week. Nov. wages can be paid by what cash on hand.
- c. Wages up to November 30, inclusive, will be paid before the end of December.

2. Unemployment Compensation for Block Chairmen:

a. Mr. Carroll:

Will consult with Mr. Housel on whether Block Chairmen are eligible or retractible for such compensation.

b. Mr. Kdie:

Read stenographic record of December 12 Conference with Mr. Rachford on eligibility of Chairmen for such compensation.

c. Mr. Nelson:

All names of Block Chairmen and dates duties as Block Chairmen commenced were submitted by Block Chairmen to Mr. Nelson.

3. Procedure on recording Chairmen's time records for the months of Sept., Oct., and November:

Mr. Nelson will confere with Mr. Housel on this point.

3. Personal Property:

Mr. Nelson received from the Regional office in San Francisco a copy of proposal of a tentative Administrative Instructions which was being submitted to Washington office for adoption. It gives a complete procedure in moving private personal property. Forms of application are available and will probably start within ten days for filling them.

4. Fair Practice Committee:

Mr. Carroll informed that no action on the part of economic divisions had been taken towards forming above entitled organization. To date only 4 petitions, 2 of them from one division and none from any mandatory division, had been brought in.

5. School Children:

Mr. Gorai proposed to advise the Education Dept. for a proper measure to be taken up in dealing with school children during recesses and after school. Proposal passed for a gendum.

6. Community Enterprises:

(Mr. Gorai proposed to advise the Education Dept. for a) Mr. Gorai proposed to request Mr. Todd's explanation on the allotment of profit raised from orders through catalog at Montgomery Ward. The proposal was recommended for discussion at the Recreation Conference on Thursday.
