1. Report on Barber's Meeting:

Mr. Nagumo reported that the barber's meeting concluded to an opinion that until the arrival of electric clippers the barbers will not operate on hand clippers. There are 12 chairs available.

2. Clothes Line:

Mr. Yokota proposed to furnish each apartment with a clothes line since sub-zero cold weathers will freeze up the clothes on outside lines. Proposal passed.

3. Coop Meeting:

Heavy taxes would be levied on the present temporary Community Enterprises and prompt set-up of a permanent Cooperative Enterprises by the residents will be the only means of escaping heavy taxes. Mr. Hayashida requested all Block Chairmen to convey Consumer Coop. Advisors in each block to be present at a meeting to be held at B. 8-25 N., Saturday at 1:30 P.M., Dec. 19.

4. Steam Cleaning of Blankets:

Mr. T. Ishikawa (B-9.) proposed to have all blankets steam-cleaned block by block. The proposal passed.

5. Chimney Sweeping:

Mr. Hayashida proposed to organize a group of chimney sweepers. Passed.

6. Japanese Literature:

Mr. Koide informed that the distribution of the Japanese books and magazines from the Pomona Assembly Center will begin tomorrow at 1:30 P.M. at 12-26 S. and requested a presentation of receipts.

7. Juvenile Delinquencies:

Mr. Kaneko suggested for consideration the cases of juvenile delinquency and requested that a proper measure be taken up. One of the Block Chairmen suggested a reformatory organization within each block which makes a connection with the Police Dept. for criminally inclined youths.

To prevent fire hazards, suggests an organization of a group of chimney sweepers. A possibility of great fire danger was discovered in the fire sparks on windy nights.
