1. Christmas meals:

Mr. Kaneko proposed to reduce meals to twice on the Christmas Day, at 9:00 A.M. and at 4 P.M. The Block Chairmen will take the matter up with respective block residents at the block meeting.

2. Promotion of Cook's Wage to Class C:

Mr. Fujimoto proposed to request a raise in cook's wages from "b" class to "c" rating. The Council ruled that with the exchange of communication with all relocation centers, similar problems can be discussed and then coordinate in petitioning the promotion of wages rates of employees in certain divisions.

3. Retirement of Block Chairmen:

Mr. Gorai suggested in a proposal that the block Chairmen retire on or before January 1, 1943 from the present duties and concede to SAC all responsibilities as the Block Chairmen. Mr. Fujimoto alleged it is untimely and it is necessary to obtain a general approval by the residents as a whole with the proposal. Mr. Hayashida pointed out that the Coordinating Committee had been formed to deal with SAC-BlockC Chairmen relationship; and this proposal would be discussed as same study.

4. Letter to the Community Council of all Relocation Centers from the Council was approved by the Council members.
