1. request Mr. Housel's presence to the Saturday Meeting at the Conference Room, January 2, 1943 to explain the purview of duties as the Project Attorney relative to the Legal Aid work.
2. request a sign put up in every shower room, both in English and in Japanese, warning against carrying money and important documents into the shower room for possible theft.

1. New Year's Entertainment:

The Council decided and concluded that the entertainment by the classic drama put on a program in blocks whose residents so desire, that such blocks directly apply at the office at 21-20-A, and that the Council shall not determine the charge of admission or guarantee of audience. Mr. Hayashida conveyed the decision to Mr. Saba.

2. Selective Service Registration:

Mr. Todd request Block Chairmen to announce at every mess hall that December 31, 1942, Thursday, is positively the last day for Selective Service Registration for those who had become 18 years of age on or before June 30, 1942 and to do so will be a criminal offense.

3. Project Attorney's Office:

Proposal to request Mr. Housel explain the purview of duties as Project Attorney relative to the Legal Aid work. Passed.

4. Punctuality of Meetings:

Mr. Nagumo proposed to keep strictly the meeting time, 9:00 A.M.--11:30 A.M., days of said meeting shall be on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday at the Administration Conference Room, effective after January 1, 1943.

5. Warning Sign against Theft:

Mr. Gorai proposed to put up a sign in every shower room against possible theft, warning against carrying valuables in the shower room. Proposal passed.
