1. P.T.C.C.:

As the result of of meeting Mr. Carter was fully satisfied with the attitude and idea of the delegates and was convinced that the Coordinating Council has served its purpose. Mr. Carter reported that he had found that such local body as this group can be recognized as a P.T.A. for one year, thence such organization will enter National P.T.A. Drs. Hashimoto and Mrs. Mitamura were elected temporary chairmen of the Council. Next session will be held ataa recreation hall on February 1 at the same time, definite place will be announced on the bulletin later.

2. Mess Hall Beautification:

Mr. Ishikawa (B-26) informed that any mess hall wishing to have paint on walls may inquire Mr. Miyachi at B-28-13-A.

3. Unemployment Compensation:

Mr. Koide reported that all Block Chairmen report to the Housing and Employment Division for unemployment compensation application

4. Clothing Allowances: Miss Payne

For families whose heads had been out for sugar beets may apply for public Grants. Such grants exclude sugar beets workers.

For families whose heads worked in November for more than 15 days but not sufficiently in October and received clothing allowance for the month of November only will be taken care by adding October allowances in December allowance. Any member of family working will be considered as an individual and will receive a separate clothing allowance check. Amount due dependants of the family will be included in one check paid in order of their family head.

6. Detective Bureau:
