1. Request installation of a hall light in every entrance of the barracks.
2. Request your reconsideration of the proposal submitted by the fire department of providing an emergency fire exit, 40" x 50" latch.
3. Increasing of hospital ambulances.
4. Request Mr. Lane's attendance to Block Chairmen's Meeting on Thursday, January 21, to explain situation involving Motor Pool and Transportations.
5. Request Mr. Lummis to expedite installation of 3/4 inch connection pipes to be connected to the fire hose in the laundry room.
6. Release of radios and cameras to residents which were confiscated by the F.B.I. and Police prior to evacuation.
7. Release for the use of center residents of non-propaganda Japanese motion-picture films now in the hands of Property Control Authority in Washington, D.C.
8. Request establishment of a junior kitchen in the hospital.
9. Requesting informations as to who, where, and how the milk is tested for grade and pasteurization before entering the project.
10. Request the attendance of Mr. Best, assistant chief steward, at Thursday's Meeting, January 21, to explain restrictions and requirements pertaining to food supplies to mess hall.
11. Request the speeded up establishment of barber shops and beauty shops as originally proposed by Mr. Todd.
