REPORT OF THE 8TH MEETING

HEART MOUNTAIN CITY PLANNING BOARD  
- Tuesday, February 2, 1943 -

The meeting was called to order at 2:15 p.m. by the Chairman, William M. Friedman. The following Board members were present:

Absent from the meeting was Bill Hosokawa of the Reports Division. Yukio Kako of the Office of Design Coordination was present as an observer.

Following a discussion of the proposed zoning map as to its purposes, advantages, technical aspects concerned, the map was approved and accepted.

At the present stage, the zoning map provides for the livestock project site northeast of the Center and for light and heavy industry zones between the warehouse and residential areas. Pending approval, the map also provides for a stadium north of Block 28, an amphitheatre north of Block 27, and space for victory gardens directly west of the Center.

A sub-committee was created to draft a set of by-laws defining the jurisdiction and authority of the Board under the self-government system. Members appointed by the Chairman were: Shig Komatsu of the War Works Division; George Nakaki representing

the Block Managers, and Shinji Fujimoto of the Community Services Division. The recommendations made by this committee are to be considered by the Board at its next meeting scheduled for Feb. 16.

It was decided that hereafter meetings of the Board would take place twice a month rather than every week.
