If a person signs "no" what will be the consequence? Will be termed disloyal but what about penalty?
2. Petition to the President of the U. S. A.
 - A. Drafted by Mr. Sashihara given to Frank Inouye
 - B. Suggested by Mr. Barber to have it placed at the place of the registration and have citizens to sign.
 - C. Suggestion made.
Status of service men's parents to be same as those of Italians and Germans.
 - D. Curtailment of anti-Japanese movements in California
3. When chairman is unable to attend the meeting to send some one in his place.
4. Mr. Barber announced his promotion to WRA office in Washington D. C., Assistant to Mr. Province. Mr. M. O. Underson taking his place here.

7. Proposal to get shots for the Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever, before people allowed to go outside.
8. Legality of the mass evacuation tested at L. A. and S. F.
9. Enterprise suggests:
 - A. Petition to be sent to Washington C. C. concerning rent for stores and clothing allowance for workers. Sacrifice is made by the residents to conduct stores in recreation halls; should not be charged.
10. Request to be made for establishment of diet kitchen in each mess hall and a dietitian to be placed at each. As the result of ration no food material comes to the stores, which in turn causes inconvenience.
11. Pay rent library, Block 6- 16-E Mr. Nakashima
Request more books. Names of owners with list of names of the books to be turned in; announce at block meeting.

Request the owners to be the members.
The membership fee, \$1.00.

12. Request the administration to announce in the Sentinel or bulletin about emergency care of snake bites and tick bites.
