- b. Why is a person sent to Leupp Center without hearing? Is it not a violation of a civil liberty, at least in spirit, if not legally? We request for fair and unbiased hearing before any person is sent away.
- c. When a person is found guilty after hearing, is he doomed to stay in the Leupp Center for the duration of the War? Are there various terms of confinement according to severity of offences similar to prison terms of three months, six months, one year, etc.? Is there any provision for release on good behavior?
- e. What are the health and sanitation provisions in the Leupp Center? Are there any doctor, nurse, or dentist?
- f. Are the food, housing and other facilities similar to those of a relocation center?
