MEMORANDUM

April 24, 1944

TO: Block Manager

SUBJECT: Transfer of Formula Duties of Block Mothers

Beginning May 1, 1944, the preparation of all formulas and distribution of Fresh Milk for the purpose of Infant Feeding will be transferred to the Block Mothers and their aids.

This change, with such short notice, is no doubt going to be subject to much criticism, but the fact remains that this is a direct order from Washington D. C., and the change will have to be made.

When this change occurs, automatically, there will be a Milk Station in each mess hall. Naturally, a new registration will be necessary for many Station. The blocks that already have two Stations will be left intact with the exception of those that carry the over-flow from their adjacent blocks. Blocks having only one station or also carrying an over-flow will please ask the Babies' Mothers to register at the Stations in their respective mess halls. In this new registration, we will require the full name, address, and the date of birth of the babies. Also what type of Formula or Fresh Milk and if the Baby is taking any type of Foods.

When this announcement is made, please be sure to state that the new set-up is effective the first of May so as to avoid any confusion. Will this matter please be given immediate attention and the new list be sent in not later than April, 1944.
