COMMENTAL COUNCIL MESTING

DATE: August 18, 1943

Wednesday

TIME: 9:00 a.m.

PLACE: Conference Room

All councilmen were present. Minutes of August 17 meeting were read and approved without correction.

Hr. Anderson informed the Council that due to attendance at a hearing at Jackson. Wyo. on establishment of the Jackson Hale Matienal somment, the Governor Hunt was unable to arrive at Heart Mountain today. It is stillunknown as to when he will arrive here.

Reports

Mr. Nagumo reported that the election for Block 17 councilson will be held on August 27 in Block 17 according to the Election Board of that block, Mr. Motoyochi is the only candidate.

The Council assigned secretary to prepare the election ballot and registration form for the election of Nr. Motojoshi.

Secretary Iwamoto read the letter of sympathy drafted by Executive Secretary Masunaga to be subsitted to Mr. Botertson. Also the letter of appreciation to individual block chairmen was read for the Council's approval. Both were accepted and the Council decided that both letters be publicated on the bulletin.

Chairmen S shiharm explained the parliamentary procedures. He conferred adoption of such procedures for the Council meeting. The Council had no objection.

Setting up cosmittees in the Council was moved by Mr. Iwasaki. Motion was seconded.
Mr. Sachihara explained the function and members of committees that the Council deems mecessary to be set up. According to the Charter, the function of a committee is policy making and in the capacity of investigation. Chairman of a committee shall be a counciloss but members may be selected from among residents who are considered competent in the kind of committee set up. Mr. Iwasaki's motion was carried unanimously.

The Council adopted following consittees under the community council:
Agriculture, Community Enterprises, Education-Recreation (including Space
Committee of Rgc. Dept.), Food, Welfare (inclusive of Housing and Clothing),
Legal Department (judicial, legislation, evacues property, other legal aspects),
Labor, Health and Sanitation, Recettlement and Public Relations, and a representative to the Community Activities Board of Equators.

Discussion on the selection and number of consittee men followed. The Council agreed on substituting individual choices of committee and concluded that such consittees as above shall be composed of 3 councilmen and no residents. No individual consitteemen shall act as representatives of the Council, hence, they shall not make any consitment unless the Council has approved such upon their consultation at the Council meeting. Mr. Yonesura moved that each councilmen subsit his choices (three) of consittee to the Chairman and that Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and Executive Sec'y shall make appointment of each councilmen to respective committees he has chosen. Notion was seconded and carried.

A representative from the Police Department requested contribution on behalf of the Zebra baseball tesm which is slated to exchange bats with the Gila Belocation Center teams. He asked that any contribution from the councilmen to forwarded to the Police Department today. The Council agreed that councilmen may contribute as individual done-ors and not as councilmen.

Mr. Yokoi brought a question of farewell party for segregants in each block. He suggested that a uniform program be set for such parties throughout the center. The Council referred the matter to the option of individual blocks.

Meeting was adjourned at 11:10 a.m.
