COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING

Sept. 16, 1943 DATE: The goday 9 All-11:30 AM TIME Conference Room PIA CR:

Attendance: Mr. Lechliter on Frust Absentees: Messrs. Merikoshi, Yokei, Block 21, Mitchie, Minutes of September 14 were read and approved with supplement.

Councilmen's work assignments were discussed at the suggestion of Mr. Magumo. Mr. Magumo proposed to assign councilmen to the coordinating board thereby entitling them to wages. The Executive Committee to draft a resolution and negotiate with Mr. Mobertson.

Mr. Lechliter was invited to the Council meeting to give a clear picture on legal aspect of the trust organization. Following is the bris outline of his explanatione: Trustee is very much comparable to an officer or a board of directors of a corporation which is actually sumed by stockholders; in case of the community enterprises, patronizers of the community enterprises are the owners of the trust, which owners are helders of patronage receipts. Promotors of a corporation is equivalent to trustees in community enterprises and the latter are not necessarily owners of the enterprises. Wha has a right only to the extent of maintaining relocation centers and has the right to dollect rent and to audit books; otherwise, giving evacuees carte blanche. There are two ways by which the declaration of trust can be changed or modified, in both instances only the trustees have the right to do so: namely, to draft a new form of trust and submit it to the people of this center by a written memorandum; or, to initiate action by themselves within the power of trustees. The present trust is set up until such time as cooperative was adopted. To that extent, the present trust can be argued as a temporary trust. A proposal for a new form of trust had been submitted to the Council which when set up will sutomatically invalidate the Declaration of Trust of the present trust. There is no legal argument in reservation of 5 store managers to be included in the new trustee organization. Original trustees were not appointed by anyone, but was at the request of the Administration they have formed a trust by signing the Desarction of Trust. Section 18 of the Heart "cuntein charter provides that the community council cannot determine or regulate what kind of organization is set up, but the Council can adopt a resolution on plans passed and subsitted by the present trustees of the Community Enterprises. Employees of the community enterprises may serve on the Board of Trustees. A trustee cannot be ousted by the Board of Trustees or by a popular vote except by his resignation or relocation or by court procedures. Present Community Enterprises is a non-profit corporation and is exempt by Anti Sherman Trust Act.

## MEPORTS:

. Mr. Massungs reported that Block Wanagers have decided that they did not went to participate in the Manpower Cossission. The Council concluded that filling a vacancy created by Mr. Miyasato's relocation can be waited till after segregation. The Council Labor Coumittee shall send an observer to the manpower conference. The Agricultural Committee reported that overtime problem is being adjusted now.

In an effort to promote favorals public relations, the Council decided to appoint Mr. Dave Yanakawa of the Community Activities whom the Council agreed to be the most competent person to direct the 3rd War Loan Bond campaign drive. (The Committee sproisted Dick Pujicks as alternate as Dave Yamakawa was unable to render services due to his heavy program)

The Council meretary was assigned to draft a men to be submitted to the Project Director on issuance of work clothing, shoes, shed, hot lunches to coal and warehouse Grew.
