

COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING

Attended: Mr. Main, Supply Officer  
Absentees: Mr. Yokoi. Tardy: Messrs. Okazaki, Motoyoshi, and Nakashima.  
Minutes of October 26 were read and passed with correction.

The Council set meetings to start at 9:30 AM sharp hereafter.  
A brief report was made on fire incident at 15-30 mess by Mr. Miyazaki.  
The Executive Secretary to send a letter of commendation to the Fire Department.

Mr. Oka proposed to request delivery of coal to last at least one month in case the delivery should be suspended due to weather or railway trouble. Mr. Main was called upon to explain the coal situation. With the present crew the maximum output of this crew per day is 7 cars, which Mr. Main agreed to order. Trouble is getting 7 cars on the right day as difficulty lies in getting coal cars through Laurel, Matana yard. However, this center is much fortunate than any other civilian wholesale companies as they are one month behind in getting orders filled compared to our one week or less delay.

Mess hall personnel problems were discussed with Mr. Main. Mr. Carroll had sent a telegram to Washington advising what has been done about establishing the standard overhead for mess hall; in the meantime, we cannot do anything.

Mr. Matsushige was instructed to look into the feasibility of a proposed organization to support evacuee doctors. Report on smooth requisition of eyeglasses was contradictory to fact. The actual requisition system has not reached the point of functioning as yet.

Councilmen's get-together party was proposed and passed. Mr. Motoyoshi, proposer, was chosen as the committee chairman who in turn selected Messrs. Masunaga, Oki, Nakaki, and Tonemura as committeemen.

Meeting was adjourned at 11:35 AM.
