RESOLUTION

Whereas, relocation is the primary objective of the WRA program;
and

Whereas, the program as offered by the Washington Administration
staff does not coincide with views of the evacuees; and

Whereas, there is a definite resistance to the relocation program
because of numerous inequalities and problems of a nature peculiar to
the status of the evacuees; and

Whereas any future plan or course of action in any WRA program
of relocation necessitates evacuee participation; and

Whereas, the WRA is constantly developing, reorganizing, and stim-
ulating methods used in this program of relocation which ultimately refers
to evacuee reactions; and

Whereas, in order to crystallize the thoughts of the evacuees of
the nine centers and the WRA staff, a conference of delegates is neces-
sary;

Therefore, be it resolved that the Community Council of Heart
Mountain through the Project Director request the WRA to call a meeting
of a sufficient number of evacuee leaders and appointed personnel from
each of the nine relocation centers to discuss these problems at some
conveniently located place in the immediate future.
