Endorsement of the Heart Mountain Council's resolution on relocation conference by the Robser Communisty Council was informed by S. Tamaki, Chairmen of the Council.

Also received was a letter from the following evacues physiciahs and surgeons acknowledging receipt of the gift presented by residents through the Council: Drs. P.K. Ibo, H.M. Kimmra, K. Nakaki, F. Eskaya, P.M. Suski.

Mr. Lane, Manufacturing superintendent, informed Mr. Todd on tofu factory in his memorandum that because of a few factors the operation of the tofu shop cennot start for another week.

There are two ways by which 'tenkemono' can be sent to intermment camps: either the intermment camp puts in a requisition for it with this center, or, individuals desiring shipment of 'tenkemono' purchase it and send it through the Gommity Enterprises. Two barrells can be arranged, according to the report. Rev. H. Kano. Executive Secretary for intermess, will be notified to the above effect by the Council secretary.

According to Mr. Anderson, it was reported, the Administration was in concurrence of opinion that a coordination board should be set up whereby councilmen can be assigned to it, thus, enabling then to perform duties as councilmen without any hindrances. Another letter on this request will be sent by the Project Director to the VRA headquarters.

Mr. Oka reported that the Agricultural Department is working on part-time moord of individuals who wolunteered to harvest crops last October and who did not have work orders.

Reporting the power of the Judicial Commission, Mr. Tokimasa referred to the Administrative Instruction No. 85. Paragraph V. Section C. At the hearing on legal technicality next Tuesday, The Council decided to request Mr. Anderson's presence.

The Health and Sanitation Committee reported delivery of the Christone gift to evacuee physicians and surgeons at \$50 per person contributed by residents.
