## HEART MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY COUNCIL MESTING CONFERENCE ROOM

January 18, 1944 Tuesday 9:30 AM-11:35 AM

Absent: Mr. Masunaga. Tardy: Messrs. Matsushige, Okazaki, and Miyazaki. Minutes of January 15 meeting were read and approved with a correction.

A communication from the Manzanar Block Managers Assembly was read. Said letter stated the inability of Manzanar sending delegates to the National Evacuee Meeting due to differences in circumstances and sentiments from other centers.

Memorandum from Mr. M. O. Anderson, Assistant Project Director, to the Council attaching a message from E. W. Meyer, Assistant to the Delegates of the International Committee of the Red Cross in Geneva, Switzerland Delegation to the United States of America, at Washington, D. C. concerning a gift from the Japanese Red Cross to the Japanese citizens in this center, was reviewed and the Council appointed the Council Food Committee as per Mr. Anderson's suggestion in dealing with the distribution of the gift as stated below:

460 barrels of soya sauce 15 barrels of bean mash 2 cases of drugs

Concensus of opinion of center block residents as reported by respective councilmen waw in concurrence with the resolution of Block 12 which was submitted to the Council January 15. Such blocks are 1, 9, 12, 17, 20, 21, 23, 25, and 30. Following blocks have submitted candidates for councilmen this morning: Blocks 8, 15, 17, 29, and 30. Blocks 9, 12, 14, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25 have expressed no intentions for submitting their candidates.

## REPORTS:

Problem of coal crew concerning work conditions was referred to the Labor Committee. Optometrists will be reduced to only one, reported Mr. Matsushige. Health and Sanitation Committee was assigned to see that Mr. Itatani, optometrist, to compile data on the volume of work and submit same to the Committee for study.
