A. communieation from the Topaz Relocation Center Commanity Council was revieved. Said Gouncil strongly adrocates allout perticipation of nine rolocation centers at the Mational Irrouee Conferemee Meeting and adde that a meeting of only Centor Delegates should be held prior to the Oonference for the exchange of ideas. The Granada Community Council in a tolegraphic message shows a vavering sapport in sending dolegates in view of Mr. Myer's teletype sefusal to bear expenses of dolegates. Mr. Seshihare draftod a thesis on topics of discuasion and agende for the Mational Ivacuee Meeting which he read before the Gownell. Motion was made to addpt in general said thesis waitton in Jppanese. Motion was seconded and carried.

The $H_{e a l}$ th and Sgnitatica Committeo deniod a runor concerning relocattoh of a deatiet who is on vacation nove The Conmittee revealed that the rate of optometrist per population is 20,000 to one on the outside. Abmormal working condition, inofficient lighting system, and general weak eyes peculiar to the Japanese race were the issuee why this center should have more than one optometrist.
The Council R settlement Committee submitted the names of eommittee on the nowly formed Relocation Planning $C_{\text {ommins }}$ sion and propoed that such conititeo and Comnission 18 to formulato demands of residents within the Center and present them to the VR , The louncil passed the proposal.
$\mathrm{Ma}_{\mathrm{g}}$. Okezaki's proposal that restriction against digging amh pits and watering the streets and ground be publicized in the supplementary bulletin wes referred to the Block Managers Commsttee.

Mr. Masumaga requested councilmen to announce at respective blocks the start of March of Dimes campaign in Heart Nountain Sunday moming for one weok.
