Attended: Messrs. G. Raymond Booth, Cincinnati Relocation Officer; Simmons, Reports Officer of the St. Louis Relocation Office.

Absentee: Mr. Yonemura. Tardy: Mr. Nagumo.

Minutes of January 25 were read and passed.

Attention was called by Mr. M. O. Anderson, Asst. Project Director, in his memorandum of January 26 to the Council to the fact that the Council get in contact with Dr. Irwin, Senior Medical Officer, as to the method of distribution of such drugs which require a physician's prescription or supervision. A copy of the tally-in sheet acknowledging receipt at Heart Mountain, 100 kegs of soya sauce and 5 kegs of bean mash was forwarded to the Council. It was dated January 27, 1944.

A letter from Mr. Fred Haller, Project Steward, addressed to Block Council requesting information as to an accurate number of evacuees living in each block was referred to the Block Managers Committee.

Mr. Masunaga reported on the meeting of Resettlement Committee with Mr. A. E. Wilde, Executive Manager of the War Finance Committee for Wyoming. It was decided that the Council appoint the chairman for the 4th War Bond Bond drive at Heart Mountain, the Council Committee reported. Floor was open for nomination and as a result, Mr. Min Yonemura was elected chairman for the drive unanimously.

Messrs. Simmons and Booth took up informal discussion on relocation. Sentiment and reception of general public on the outside towards the Japanese race were related in detail.

Meeting was adjourned at 11:40 a.m.
