Minutes of January 28 meeting were read and approved,

Mr. Matsushige reported on the procedure of issubing clothing allowances.

Patients in the hospital who have been confined for an indefinite period receive only public assistance grant and no clothing allowance.

According to a report to Mr. Anderson, (shoyu sent from Japan now stored in the warehouse has) leakage of shoyu was indicated on the floor and it was requested by Mr. Anderson that the Council Food Committee investigate as to whether the shoyu has been pilferred or it is just a mere leakage. Mr. Iwasaki reported that the Council Food Committee decided to distribute the shoyu sent from the Japanese Red Cross to each block on a basis of one keg to each barrack, the distribution to block residents is left at the discretion of the block.

Issuance of surplus items in warehouses such as mops, brooms, soaps, be made to residents was proposed and passed. Providing soaps for the coal crew was also proposed and referred to the Block Managers committee.

Mr. Tokimasa was advised to submit the amendment of gambling section of the criminal code to the Council.

The secretary reported on the election results and announced new nominees from the eight other blocks for which special elections were set.

Meeting was adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
