Minutes of February 4 passed without correction.

Mr. Oki reported that USO are in charge of erecting a service flag and an honor roll board for every nisei in Heart Mountain serving in the Armed Forces.

The Welfare Director to request for information re repatriation, and to Mr. D. M. Todd, Assistant Project Director, on construction of gravel sidewalks.

Mr. Harold Erdman requested the councilmen to convey a request that washing tubs be cleansed after using and agreed to put up a sign in each laundry room in both English and Japanese.

Date for the evacuee meeting being decided upon, discussion took place on location of the conference. Mr. Sashihara asserted that the majority of other relocation centers prefer more centralized location for the conference. Since it would take several days in reaching a decision upon any one subject, valuable time and initiative would be lost, hence, an extra unaccounted-for expense would be incurred upon the delegates. Therefore, the conference with WRA officials is secondly to a preliminary evacuee conference among delegates only in order that conclusive basis for argument or presentation to be made in the regular conference can be formed. Mr. Sashihara contended and moved that the first conference be called in a relocation center. Motion was seconded and favored by a vote of 12:4 but, hence, 12 votes constituted no quorum it was decided to proceed as planned. Mr. Nakaki moved that Chairman ask as an individual, reaction of other relocation center community councils as to where and how they want the conference and that we follow the consensus of their opinion. Motion was passed.

Mr. Iwasaki moved to send Mr. Yoshitaro Wada of Block 6-15-E, a letter of appreciation for his efforts in making tsukemon for the whole center. Passed.

Meeting was adjourned at 11:40 AM. Next meeting was set for Friday as a joint session for the new and incumbent at 9:30 AM.
