

HEART MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING
Block Managers Office

February 15, 1944
Tuesday
9:30 AM--11:35 AM

The first meeting of the Heart Mountain Community Council was held at the Block Managers Office at 9:30 AM, Tuesday, February 15, 1944.

Roll call was taken. Mr. Motoyoshi was tardy.

The Council secretary called the meeting to order. Immediately election of chairman of the Council was held. Messrs. Nakashima, Hayashida, Fujimoto, and Nagano were nominated: Mr. Nakashima was elected chairman with a vote of 11 against Mr. Hayashida's 9 in the re-election as they tied in the first election with a vote of 6 each against 4 each of Messrs. Fujimoto and Nagano. Next election of vice-chairman was held and Mr. Fujimoto received 11 against Mr. Nagano's 5. Mr. Nakaki was elected executive secretary with 13 ballots against 6 for Mr. Fujii.

Appointment of councilmen to the Council sub-committee was discussed. The number of persons to serve in any one committee was limited to two, provided if necessary the Council may appoint additional councilmen. A list of councilmen serving on the sub-committees is attached to the minutes.

Mr. Shigio Masunaga from Block 7 tendered resignation effective February 28. The Council appointed Messrs. Hayashida and Kinosita as the Council Election Committee to supervise the special election for Block 7 councilmen and set the date of election for Monday, February 28.

At the request of the sponsorer of Kei-Ro-Kai banquet to be held Saturday at 22-30, Mr. Nakashima, chairman, was elected to speak for the Council.

Number of the Council meetings during a week was discussed. The chairman has authority to call special meetings whenever he deems necessary, therefore, the Council shall continue to be held twice a week on Tuesdays and Fridays as heretofore been done. Punctuality of meeting was stressed. Meetings are to start at 9:00 AM sharp and end not later than 11:30 AM hereafter.

The Executive Committee was assigned to negotiate on assignment of job-less councilmen to block coordinators. Mr. Nagano moved that no councilman shall hold dual positions; he shall have to choose between block coordinator's position and any job to which he may be originally assigned. Pros and cons discussion ensued. The Council assigned the Legal Committee to look into the validity of Mr. Nagano's motion in relation to the Charter.

Meeting adjourned at 11:35 AM.
