

HEART MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING
CONFERENCE ROOM

February 23, 1944
Wednesday
9:20 AM--11:30 AM

This special session was called by the chairman.

Roll call was taken: Mr. Masunaga was absent and Messrs. Fujimoto, Tonooka, Matsushige, Hayashida, Funokai, and Oka were tardy.

Minutes of the February 22 meeting were read and passed.

Administrative Notice #22 was reviewed. Subject: Penalties for violation of Council regulations. Provision of suspension of work privileges, clothing allowances, etc., has been repealed since the release of the Community Government manual, Section 30.6.4-A. The Legal Committee was referred to the repeal of the penalties provision section of the criminal code of Heart Mountain. A supplement provision of the criminal code with reference to the Section 6 was submitted by the Legal Committee, to wit:

Sub-section "A" of Section Six:

Any person who is present within a room or building or structure where any game is conducted or played with cards, dice, or other device for money, checks, credits, or any other thing of value shall be deemed *prima facie* guilty of misdemeanor.

Mr. Tokimasa moved that the above supplement be instituted as amendment in the criminal code and be adopted as an ordinance. The Council passed the motion unanimously.

Mr. Edd, Assistant Project Director, requested the councilmembers and Block Managers to be present at a meeting to be held Friday morning at 10:30 AM, February 25. Mr. Ernest J. Goppert, former State Commander of the American Legion will speak on the Selective Service Laws.

Block 2 residents submitted an appeal to the Council through Mr. Tonooka, Block 2 councilman, on removal of a pool hall from Block 2. The Recreation Committee was charged with the negotiation in behalf of Block 2.

Mr. Saito requested the Community Enterprise Committee to investigate and report to the Council on the alleged reduction of sales prices of certain merchandise sold at the community stores, on shoyu, and on the enterprise operation policies. Inconsistency of Mr. Iwasaki's position as a member of the Community Enterprises Board of Trustees while serving on the Council's Community Enterprises Committee was opinioned by Mr. Saito. Mr. Iwasaki withdrew from the C. E. Committee and he will be replaced by another councilman to be appointed by the chairman.

Meeting was adjourned at 11:30 AM.
