

HEART MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING
CONFERENCE ROOM

February 25, 1944
Friday
9:00 AM--10:45 AM

Absentee: Mr. S. Masunaga. Tardy: Messrs. Matsushige, Saito, Tokimasa, and Oka.

Minutes of February 23 meeting were passed without correction.

The distribution of Red Cross shipment was reported by Mr. Hayashida, Food Committee. Except Blocks 7 and 25, remainders received 268 packages of green tea, each package weighing 1 pound. Block 7: 89 packages. Block 25: 201 packages. 6 remaining packages were donated to the hospital. Bean rash also was distributed to the block offices. Each block's quota was 7056 pounds except 53 pounds for Block 25 and 23 pounds for Block 7.

Mr. Tani reported that Mr. Dearing and Dr. Kimura thought a part of medicine such as takadiastase shipment should be kept at the hospital due to the necessity of a medical officer's prescription.

The Council deemed such medicine is not necessary to be prescribed by the doctor, and determined to request the hospital to release the medicine to be distributed to each block office, to be kept there.

In recognition of Miss Virgil Payne's work in general as Social Welfare Director by a report made by Mr. Matsushige, the Council expressed its gratitude.

Mr. T. Kinoshita was appointed to the Community Enterprises Committee to fill a vacancy created by Mr. Iwasaki's withdrawal.

Mr. Matsushige requested councilmen to inform respective block residents to obtain a pass to see off any person leaving the center at the bus depot from respective divisional or sectional heads. For the unemployed such passes are issued by the Social Welfare office.

Remuneration for evacuee physicians and surgeons for their services was discussed but was postponed for further discussion.

With respect to the deceased mother of Mr. S. Masunaga, Mr. Nagumo's motion to send the Council's delegate to the wake and funeral services was passed and Mr. Matsushige was appointed.

The chairman ordered a special session tomorrow at nine and adjourned the meeting at 10:45 AM.
