

HEART MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING  
CONFERENCE ROOM

February 26, 1944  
Saturday  
9:00 AM--11:35 AM

Roll call was taken and Messrs. Masunaga and Fujii were absent while Messrs. Tonooka, Matsushige were tardy.

Minutes of February 25 were read and approved without correction.

Mr. Takahashi on the Health and Sanitation Committee reported that the distribution of the medicine received from the Japanese Red Cross will be made upon a written request by the Council, according to Mr. Dearing, Hospital Administrator.

With respect to pamphlets distributed among the center residents wherein the alleged Council's inactivities regarding the welfare of the residents were charged by a so-called Fair Play Committee of Heart Mountain, it was the general opinion of the Council to disregard such a propoganda. Mr. Motoyoshi moved that the appointed Council's Committee carry on its concrete plan so as to expedite its application with reference to general sentiments of the draftable nisei on the draft problem.

Various proposals were submitted for discussion.  
Following matters were referred to the Welfare Committee:

1. Distribution of brooms, soap, buckets (wooden or metal), mops to needy families.
2. Repairing ~~of the~~ floors of apartments where necessary.
3. Distribution of wire screens to the block offices whereupon volunteer crew in each block will put them on the windows of the apartments.

Along with the request for repairing the floors of an apartment, Mr. Tonooka proposed to request the Administration to expedite operations of the maintenance by citing an example of puttying window panes and repairing leaking roofs, and if necessary, to increase the crews. The proposal passed.

The Legal Committee was designated to establish regulation concerning control of pets in view of the maintenance of sanitation and controlling a public nuisance.

Unfinished business was reviewed and referred to the respective committees.

Meeting was adjourned at 11:35 AM.
