

HEART MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING
CONFERENCE ROOM

March 17, 1944
9:00 AM - 12:00 P.

Absentee: Block 17. Tardy: Mr. Matsushige.

Meeting was called to order by Mr. S. Fujimoto, Vice-Chairman.
Minutes of March 14 were read and approved.

Communications were reviewed:

Letter from Poston Community Council on Petition sent to the President of the United States; from M. O. Anderson on Relationship with Spanish Embassy; from Rohwer Community Council a copy of the translation in Japanese of Mr. Myer's speech delivered at the American Legion Convention in Indianapolis, Indiana; from Dave Yamakawa on appointment of a representative to the C. A. Board of Trustees; from E. W. Myer, Assistant to Delegate, in reference to the soya sauce; and from Guy Robertson on Appointment of a Food Coordinator.

Mr. Saito requested that shoyu from Red Cross be distributed immediately.

Mr. Tani reported that Dr. Irwin said there were no means of curbing contagious diseases other than through education. Therefore, Dr. Irwin will issue bulletins from time to time which will also be translated into Japanese and delivered throughout the center. These bulletins will be in series and pertain to all contagious diseases.

Mr. Katagi of the Education Committee reported that after discussing with Miss Virginia Lynn, Vocational Counselor, on scholarship fund, it was decided to negotiate with the C.A. Board of Trustees for raising a Fund. After a careful study plans will be referred to the Council for approval or for further advice.

Mr. Matsushige reported that Evacuee Property Board advised to give Power of Attorney to WRA Attorney individually, so WRA will have grounds to fight legally.

Mr. Nagumo, election committee for Block 17, request that it is necessary for a check up on the qualification for Mr. Saijo's candidacy. The Council referred it to the Executive Secretary.

Mr. Tokimasa, Legal Committee, reported that in the case of resignation for Judicial Commissioners, it is necessary to elect and fill the vacancy as soon as possible.

The regulation for pets was drafted by the Legal Committee. After discussion the Council decided to refer to the Legal Committee and Police Department.

Mr. Fujimoto requested that investigation should be made for the facts about the assailment of a high school boy by a high school teacher. It was referred to the Education Committee.

The Council decided that it is necessary to have a cross check up for the workers in Heart Mountain Center by divisions. Matter was referred to the Labor Committee.

Meeting was adjourned at 12:00 PM.
