
To: Mr. Shoji Naguma Block 12, Councilman 12-24-AB

Subject: Proposed meeting with foreman of Agriculture Section

With respect to the meeting which you have proposed with the foreman of the Agriculture Section this afternoon at 1:00 p.m., I wish to request that this meeting not be held. I believe that it is inadvisable for members of the Block Councilmen or other organizations or groups in the Center to arrange meetings pertaining to the operation of any project unless approved by the head of the section involved or other authorized person. I feel that such a practice could lead to considerable difficulty and might undermine the unity and cooperative attitude which we are all trying to achieve.

With respect to the particular problem involved, I wish to advise that we are attempting to ascertain all the facts in the case and do not feel that a meeting should be held until such time as the facts are available and all points of view properly represented. When this investigation has been completed our further course of action will be determined. I wish to assure you that we have no desire to be unfair to anyone and for this reason feel that we must have an adequate study of the situation before any meetings are held which might result in an unjust expression of opinion, decision, or commitment.
