The following suggestions were formulated:

1. The clothing allowance be granted to all center residents.
2. At least one person in each family be given a work enabling other members of his family to receive clothing allowances.
3. The needy family, needy residents over 65 years old or invalids be given maximum public aid grant and clothing allowance.

The above matters were discussed thoroughly with Miss Payne and her fullest efforts will be given to gain these ends.
