

HEART MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING

April 17, 1944

Minutes of April 11 was read and corrected as follows: addition to paragraph 8, "Suggestion was also made to request for Doctors from the list of parolable doctors at Santa Fe Detention Camp, New Mexico".

1. Mr. George Nakaki and Mr. Matsushige were appointed by the chairman as delegates of Block Managers, Buddhist Ministers, and Christian Ministers to discuss the means by which to counsel these young men who were taken in custody for failure to report for physical examination. Secretary was asked to notify Mr. N. Kawai of their appointments, together with a request for publication in Japanese of his editorial and the letter from A.C.L.U. to Mr. K. Okamoto.
2. Mr. Katagi reported that since TB film mentioned by Mr. Takahashi at our previous meeting has been shown to various groups that those interested in having the picture shown submit their request to C.A.
3. Mr. Miyazaki was appointed to the Committee to draft the record of the amount of losses incurred from evacuation compiled with that of other centers for the purpose of presenting whenever necessary.
4. The Council unanimously approved the continuance of Block Managers.
5. Mr. Tokimasa gave a brief interpretation of the WPB regulations.
6. Mr. Anderson announced that there will be about 500 evacuees transferred to Heart Mountain on June 14 instead of 1,000 as previously reported and for the present time 125 segregated evacuees will be sent to Tule Lake on May 17. Gila River Relocation Center will take 2,000 evacuees, more than any other center except Rohwer Relocation Center where most of the evacuees will be transferred.
