

HEART MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING
SPECIAL MEETING

July 19, 1944
10:00 a.m.--11:45 a.m.

The Special Meeting of the Community Council was called to order by Chairman Nakashima. Mr. Guy Robertson, Project Director, and Mr. M. O. Anderson, Assistant Project Director, were present. Chairman stated the topics for this morning's discussion. A. Arrangement for doctors to call at apartments on emergency cases. B. Maintenance of Block Coordinator position.

On the first topic discussed on arrangement to be made with doctors to call at apartments on emergency cases, Mr. Hatchimonji and Mr. Miyazaki, related cases which had occurred at their respective blocks. Mr. Robertson recognized the circumstances of those cases. Although it is not the policy of the hospital because of shortage of doctors to make individual home call to the apartment, he asked the Chairman of the Council, Mr. Anderson, and Dr. Irwin, Chief Medical Officer, to consider a possible plan whereby such special cases may be attended by the doctor at the home.

The problem of maintenance of the Coordinators position was discussed. The arguments of the Councilmen in retaining this position were that the block work required cannot be satisfactorily fulfilled if the Councilman is employed at other job, that the work of the sub-committees which have been done very efficiently cannot be accomplished. While it was stated by the Administrative Staff that Councilmen may be excused from work to perform official Council duties, some of the work customarily done by Councilman in the past can be done by the Managers, and that theoretically if the Councilmen are not on the payroll as such they will not be administratively influenced by the Administration. Since there was no time left for further discussion, the meeting was adjourned at 11:45 a.m.
