Subject: Use of Mess Halls for Recreational Purposes

As a follow up to my notice under the date of October 8th relative to the use of mess halls and other buildings for recreational and allied activities, we are announcing that in the future all of these activities will be concentrated at four mess halls, located at 8-30, 12-30, 20-27, and 22-30.

As it has already been stated, much confusion has resulted from miscellaneous use of these buildings by people who have not scheduled their meetings through the Recreation Department. In the interest of efficiency, all requests concerning such activities should be made to the office of Marlin Kurtz, Recreation Director. Full cooperation in this respect will soon eliminate confusion for residential groups desiring various types of recreation.

The mess halls that are to be used on the recreation program, are to be equipped with screens separating the kitchen from the dining room, in order that their use will be most sanitary. The Recreation Department will also furnish for authorized activities, a work crew to clear out the mess halls, to properly clean them, and to replace tables following each session.

With this notice, it is to be understood that no mess halls other than specified above, are to be used for activities other than for serving meals to the residents.
