SUBJECT: Duties of Janitors & Boiler Firemen

In order to divide up the duties of janitors and boiler firemen in the various blocks, it is desirous of relieving the boiler firemen of the care of some of the heating stoves.

By this arrangement it will be necessary for the janitors to fire 3 of the heating stoves in the washrooms and the boiler firemen 3 stoves. You will make your arrangements accordingly.

I suggest that the woman in charge of the sewing room be relieved from any sewing room duty, that the keys to these rooms be given to the block chairman and that the sewing room woman be assigned to stove duty only, as was originally intended.
