Offers continue to come in for various types of employment. Domestic workers are in great demand, and a number of part-time domestic offers have also been received.

## SUMMARY OF CURRENT HOUSING SITUATION

Rooms for single persons can be easily secured. In this respect, the USO-Travelers Aid agency has been very cooperative. Housekeeping rooms present some difficulty in locating, and those that are easily obtainable are not always satisfactory. Apartments and flats take long hours of searching, but they can be secured.

To wash and grease cars in garages. Wages, \$25 per week and up.

DOCK WORKER

To work in transfer company, handling freight on docks. 60 hours weekly. Wages, 65¢ an hour for 54 hours. 1½ overtime.

FACTORY WORKER

Men between 18 and 30 years to work in the manufacture of army ammunition boxes. Wages, 54¢ to 78¢ per hour. 1½ over 40 hours. 55 hours weekly.

FIREMAN

To work in boiler room of a large hotel from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM. Wages, \$150 a month.

HOSPITAL WORKER

Boilerman in Catholic hospital. \$20 per week with complete maintenance. Freeport, Ill.

JANITOR

2 for neighborhood theater for 4 hours daily. Wages, \$11.20 per week.

MECHANIC, AUTO

60¢ to \$1.00 per hour depending on ability and experience.

PRESSER.

Experienced operators of pressing machines in large cleaning establishments. Wages, \$1.00 per hour.

SPOTTER

Experienced spotter in large cleaning establishment. Wages, \$1.25 per hour and up.

STOCK CLERK

Work in stockroom of cafeteria. Wages, \$75 per month plus meals; bonus arrangement in addition to salary.

VEGETABLE CLERK

Work in vegetable commissary of Camp Grant. 40-hour week. Wages, \$28 per week.

WASHER

In the benzine and cleaning room of large cleaning establishment. Wages according to ability. No experience necessary.

Experienced woman for large Catholic hospital in Davenport, Iowa. Wages \$100 to \$150 per month plus board.

Offers for three couples. Wages, \$125 to \$150 per month with room and board.

INSTITUTION

Woman to cook and man to do janitor work in Catholic boys' high school. Meals to be prepared for 12 adult instructors only. Wages, \$130 per month with room and board.

NURSERY

Middle-aged couple desired. Woman to cook for husband and one Nisei employee. Husband will work in outdoor nursery. Wages, \$100 per month. Everything furnished in 3-room cottage except bedding and bed linen. Owners of nursery have a farm where vegetables may be obtained without cost.
