SUMMARY OF CURRENT JOB OFFER SITUATION

Farm offers have recently comprised a large number of the offers received in this area. Following this trend, a number of inquiries have been received from the projects for farming opportunities. Individual attention is given to such inquiries in order to assist in placing individuals and families in the type of farming in which they are interested. Last month, placements were made on different farms involving the relocation of several families.

SUMMARY OF CURRENT HOUSING SITUATION

The housing situation remains about the same. On farm offers housing is available. In cities, furnished rooms for single persons are available from about \$4.00 to \$7.00 per week. Apartments and houses are scarce. Unfurnished apartments for couples start from about \$35.00 per month. Housing for families start from about \$40.00 per month unfurnished. Furnished housing ranges from about \$50.00 to \$55.00.
